

Staffer Guidelines

General Guidelines:

1. Staffers must arrive on time to every scheduled session and event.
2. MP3/Ipod players may only be used during scheduled breaks.
3. Only Christian music is allowed during GA Camp. If you are not sure if something is acceptable, then do not bring it to camp.
4. Staffers are expected to attend all scheduled sessions and should be alert and awake during those times.
5. Cell phones and car keys are to be turned into Libby at the beginning of camp. They will be safely stored and returned to you on Friday. The only exception is the Junior & Senior Staffers, who have earned the privilege to use their phones responsibly for GA Camp communication only.

Dress Code:

1. Shorts must be finger-tip length.
2. Shirts must have sleeves- no tank top or sleeveless shirts.
3. Shoes must be closed toe and closed heel unless walking to and from the pool.
4. Modest one-piece bathing suits only.

Conduct Code:

1. Staffers are expected to be an example to the GA's in their word and actions.
2. Respect one another's possessions - do not "borrow" belongings without permission.
3. Love one another. If another staffer is having a hard time, help her out! Be considerate of each other.
4. Cliques will not be tolerated. Just as the church is to be unified, we will be unified.
5. Staffers are REQUIRED to mingle with GA's during mealtimes and worship.
6. Persistent bad attitudes will result in dismissal from camp.
7. Be on the look-out for GA groups that need your help. You are here to serve, but you may have to look for opportunities to do so.

2. Forms of accountability may result in a warning and/or dismissal.
